The strength of Assolombarda

The relevance of Assolombarda within the Life Sciences is proven by our role in two strategic entities:

The Lombardy Life Science Cluster, created by Lombardy Region, is a public-private organization that promotes the collaboration among public and private stakeholders within the industry, from universities to enterprises



The National Life Science Cluster, created by the Ministry of Education, University and Research, which represents the main national industrial associations and support the development of the industrial policies for the industry at the national level



The relevance of the Life Science Industry in Lombardy

Lombardy Region has a very strategic role in life sciences compared to other Italian Regions, given the high presence of companies in the territory

Lombardy life science industry presents a value of output of 55,8 billion euro (30% of the industry value added at the national level)

The value added is equal to 20,7 billion euro (22,3% of the industry value added at national level) The overall value added of the life science industry in Lombardy GDP is 11% (in Italy 10% of the GDP) Lombardy life science industry employs almost 339.000 people (19,9% of the population employed within the industry in Italy)

Energy Industry

The energy sector in Assolombarda includes leading Italian companies involved in the production, transportation and distribution of conventional and non-conventional energy. Group key words: smart city and energy efficiency.

Our companies are qualified to design extraction methods and focused on the future of the energy market (smart cities, energy-saving, home automation systems, etc.).





Italian manufacturing export (billion euro)





Manufacturing trade surplus - 2017 (US billion dollar)




Share of global manufacturing value added - 2018 (% on current prices - US dollar)





Export (billion euro)







Repositioning on extra-EU markets: the case of Milan - 2018








